Results of the piano pre-selection

Geneva, 13 June 2014 – 44 young pianists aged 17 to 29 years old from 9 countries have been selected to participate in the 69th Geneva Competition Piano & Flute from 15 November – 5 December 2014.

The pre-selection Jury, presided by Pascal Rogé, met in Geneva from 10 – 12 June. From the 174 applications received from all around the world, 44 particularly talented young musicians were selected to participate in the piano competition, which takes place this November in Geneva. Aged from 17 to 29 years old, the candidates come from South Korea, Japan, France, Russia, China, Italy, Taiwan, the United States and Canada. An important participation from Asian countries is to be noted, with almost half of the candidates from South Korea.

The 69th Geneva International Music Competition will take place from 15 November – 5 December in Geneva. This year's disciplines are piano and flute. Complete programme: www.concoursgeneve.ch
